Giving Circle Annual Meeting

Giving Circle Donors gather annually to select which nonprofit organizations will receive funding from the most recent Giving Circle year donations.

Donors will be sent invitations at least 30 days prior to the event, giving notice of the location, date and time of the **Giving Circle Annual Meeting**.

(Note: there is no additional cost for each Giving Circle Donor to attend the Annual Meeting.)

Mail Your Ballot or Vote at the Meeting!

Additionally, prior to the Annual Meeting, Donors will receive a ballot with the list of eligible nonprofit organizations being considered for current year Giving Circle funding.

Grant recipients are announced each year during the **Giving Circle Annual Meeting**.

Giving Circle Cycle

Each Giving Circle year begins on October 1 and ends on September 30 of the following year.

The Fund’s Annual Meeting date will be held within 60 days of the end of the cycle.

Every **Giving Circle Donor** is entitled to cast one ballot in the Fund’s annual grantee selection process.

Donors may nominate one or more Clark County area nonprofit organizations to be considered for funding by the Giving Circle annual grantee selection process.

Area nonprofits may also “self-nominate” to be considered for funding.

Clark County area nonprofit organizations (*nominated or self-nominated*) will be given a **Giving Circle Grant Application** for timely completion. Eligible nonprofit organizations will be placed on the ballot for Donors to consider and vote upon.
